ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

Before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) for consideration and disposition is the Petition for Reconsideration and/or Clarification of the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (CAUSE-PA) filed on May 9, 2025. The Petition for Reconsideration seeks reconsideration and/or clarification of the Commission’s April 24, 2025 Order denying the December 11, 2024 Petition of Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC to amend its Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan for 2019-2024.

Pursuant to Rule 1701 of the Pennsylvania Rules of Appellate Procedure, Pa. R.A.P. § 1701 (relating to effect of appeal generally), the Commission must act to grant a petition for reconsideration within thirty days of the date of entry of the order for which reconsideration is sought or otherwise lose jurisdiction to do so if a petition for review is timely filed.¹ The thirty-day period within which the Commission must act on the Petition for Reconsideration in order to preserve jurisdiction relative to the April 24, 2025 Order ends on May 27, 2025. CAUSE-PA timely filed the Petition for Reconsideration on May 9, 2025. Accordingly, we shall grant reconsideration pending a review on the merits; **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Petition for Reconsideration filed by the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania on May 9, 2025, is hereby granted, pending further review of, and consideration on, the merits of the Petition.
