Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36. Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:



Request for Information

1.) Question #10 of the application.

Please revise your territory request to indicate only the areas from which you intend to originate service. The territory needs to be clear and concise. Do not use language such as “but not limited to”. Your proposed service area includes six counties (Allegheny, Bedford, Blair, Cambria, Centre, and Huntington) with no proven company-owned vehicle, limited verified cash assets and only one facility. The Commission will not approve authority requests that exceed the ability to provide safe, efficient, and reasonable service.

- Territory can be added in the future when additional resources become available.

2.) Question #5 of the applicant’s verified statement requires that you describe your hiring and employment policies that satisfies the requirements of *52 Pa Code § 29.505*.

Criminal history. Since this check must be done every two years for those you employ, how will you make sure it is done every two years?

3.) Financial Position.

A.) You may not include assets which are not owned by the applicant in the balance sheet. In your most recent response, a title provided shows that the listed vehicle is

not owned by the applicant. Transfer the title to the applicant (M&J Well LLC) and submit verifiable proof or remove this asset from the balance sheet.

- B.) Based on the verifiable information provided to be evaluated including the applicant's bank statement ending balance of \$20.00, M&J Well LLC lacks the financial position to gain a Certificate of Public Convenience. The applicant will be given a last opportunity to provide evidence that it is financially able to provide its proposed services, such as providing an improved bank account statement.
- As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards.

Note: If you are having trouble with your reply and/or improving your financial position, you are encouraged to consult with an attorney and/or a financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier related proceedings. If the LLC has not yet been fully funded, then it should be NOW.
