Dear Mr. Brechlin:

The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Duquesne Light Company's proposed Supplement No. 92 to Tariff Electric-Pa. P.U.C. No. 25 and the supporting rate computations submitted on April 28, 2025 to become effective on June 1, 2025.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Default Service Supply (DSS) rates, which includes Electric Vehicle Time-of-Use (E-TOU) rates, for the Residential & Lighting and Small Commercial & Industrial classes for the six-month period of June 1, 2025 through November 30, 2025 and the Medium Commercial & Industrial classes for the three-month period of June 1, 2025 through August 31, 2025; and the Fixed Retail Administrative (FRA) rate for the twelve-month period of June 1, 2025 through May 31, 2026 are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The DSS and FRA are subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter. Any subsequent submissions to the Commission related to this docketed case should reference Docket No. M-2025-3054828.
