## **Affidavit of Notice and Demand for Credit Correction**

I, Shasta Patrice Brown, Executor for Ren-Ira Michal Zuri-El, Private Estate and SHASTA PATRICE BROWN ESTATE, do hereby submit this Affidavit of Notice regarding the ongoing dispute under Docket No. C-2024-3050759 against PECO Philadelphia Electric Company.

It has come to my attention that despite the disputed and closed status of account number# 2779608000, a PECO account(which includes another closed account), a derogatory collection entry has been reported to national credit bureaus, reflecting a balance transferred to FirstPoint Collection Resources between May 28, 2025 and June 1, 2025.

This act constitutes:

- Violation of the Fair Credit Reporting Act (15 U.S.C. § 1681s-2),
- False representation of debt ownership,
- Ongoing harm to my private credit reputation,
- Material misrepresentation by PECO, and
- Unauthorized third-party disclosure of disputed, unverified, and inaccurate information.

As Executor, I demand:

1. Immediate removal of the derogatory reporting;
2. Formal correction of credit entries with all bureaus;
3. Full investigation and enforcement by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission;
4. Sanctions for PECO's failure to adhere to public utility regulations and consumer protections.

I reserve all rights, remedies, and defenses under Divine Law, commercial law, and Pennsylvania utility law.
