TO CONSUMERS WHO WISH TO TESTIFY AT A PUBLIC INPUT HEARING: Please note that this is not the notice for the public input hearings, where consumers may give testimony regarding the proposed rate increase. A telephonic public input hearing will be held on June 5, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. Witnesses who testify at the public input hearing are not required to participate in the evidentiary hearings that will be held on June 16, 2025, and June 17, 2025.

FAILURE TO APPEAR: If you are an **Active Participant** in this proceeding, meaning that you advised the Administrative Law Judges that you wish to have an active role in this proceeding and submit evidence, witnesses and testimony in the technical evidentiary hearings, you may lose the case if you do not take part in this hearing and present evidence on the issue(s) raised. Your case or claim may be dismissed “with prejudice” which means that you will be barred from filing another complaint raising the same claim(s) and issue(s) presented in the dismissed complaint.

CONTINUANCES. You may request a continuance of the hearing if you have a good reason. All continuances will be granted only for good cause. To request a continuance, you must submit a written request (a “motion”) at least five (5) days before the hearing. Your motion should include: 1) The case name, number, and hearing date; 2) The reason for the request; and 3) Whether the other party agrees (or if you do not know).

REPRESENTATION. If you are an individual, you may represent yourself or you may have an attorney represent you. All others, including a partnership, corporation, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision, must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania, or admitted *pro hac vice*. Only an attorney may represent someone else.

PRESENTING EXHIBITS. If you intend to present any documents or exhibits into the hearing record, such documents or exhibits should be attached to your written testimony pursuant to the litigation schedule established at the prehearing conference on June 3, 2025. Proposed exhibits should be properly pre-marked for identification purposes. The admission of documents and exhibits at the evidentiary hearing may be permitted or denied at the discretion of the presiding officers.

ACCOMMODATION. Any party who needs an accommodation for a disability in order to participate in this hearing process may request one. Please call the OALJ scheduling office at least five (5) business days prior to your hearing to submit your request.

If you require an interpreter to participate in the hearing, please call the scheduling office at least ten (10) business days prior to your hearing to submit your request.

E-FILING. The PUC offers a free e-Filing Subscription Service. This service allows a user to file documents electronically and receive an automatic email notification whenever a document is added, removed, or changed on the PUC website in a specific case. PAPER FILING. If you do not have the capability to open and use an e-Filing account, you may file paper documents with the Secretary of the Commission. Filing of paper documents must be sent by overnight delivery to:
