**MOTION OF COMCAST BUSINESS COMMUNICATIONS LLC FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO COMPLAINT**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA UTILITY COMMISSION:

In accordance with Section 1.15 of the Pennsylvania Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure, Comcast Business Communications LLC (“Comcast”), by and through its counsel, Obermayer Rebmann Maxwell & Hippel LLP, files this Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to Complaint. In connection with this Motion, Comcast avers as follows:

1. Comcast seeks a 30-day extension of time to file an Answer to the Complaint in the above-captioned matter in light of a pending resolution between the Complainant and Comcast that would resolve the Formal Complaint.
2. On May 2, 2025, Complainant, Robert Goeke, filed a Formal Complaint with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”) against Comcast Business Communications LLC (“Comcast”). He alleged his monthly bill for Comcast unjustifiably and inexplicably increased to \$218 per month.
3. The Commission served Mr. Goeke’s Formal Complaint on Comcast on May 16, 2025.

4. Since receiving Mr. Goeke's Formal Complaint, Comcast and Mr. Goeke have been working cooperatively to identify and execute a non-judicial resolution of Mr. Goeke's Formal Complaint.

5. While the parties' non-judicial resolution remains underway, Comcast and Mr. Goeke require additional time to finalize their resolution.

6. In light of the ongoing resolution efforts between Comcast and Mr. Goeke to resolve the Formal Complaint, and in the interest of judicial economy, Comcast requests a 30-day extension of time to respond to the Formal Complaint to allow time for Comcast and Mr. Goeke to resolve the Formal Complaint without judicial intervention.

WHEREFORE, Comcast respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to Complaint and permit it an additional 30 days to respond to the Complaint.
