On behalf of Raiser-PA LLC ("Raiser"), enclosed is a firm check from Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney for two hundred dollars (\$200.00), which is the fine amount requested by the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement to terminate further proceedings in connection with the above-captioned Amended Complaint filed on June 4, 2025 ("Amended Complaint"). The Amended Complaint alleges that Raiser is subject to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to a license issued to Raiser at Docket No. A-2016-2580821 on January 26, 2017, authorizing the transportation of persons for compensation in Transportation Network Company ("TNC") service. In addition, the Amended Complaint alleges that Raiser is in violation of Chapter 26 of the Public Utility Code and related regulations by operating a vehicle with front steer tires with two adjacent tread grooves less than 2/32" tread remaining.

Rasier does not contest payment of the requested fine and is forwarding this amount in order to resolve and close this Amended Complaint.
