
Dear Secretary Homsher:

On behalf of Raiser-PA LLC ("Raiser"), enclosed is a firm check from Buchanan Ingersoll & Rooney for two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), which is the fine amount requested by the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement to terminate further proceedings in connection with the above-captioned Complaint ("Complaint"). The Complaint alleges that Raiser is subject to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to a license issued to Raiser at Docket No. A-2016-2580821 on January 26, 2017, authorizing the transportation of persons for compensation in Transportation Network Company ("TNC") service. In addition, the Complaint alleges that Raiser is in violation of 52 Pa. Code §29.405, regarding common carriers and contract carriers maintaining a vehicle's required annual state inspection.

Rasier denies that it operates in Pennsylvania as a common carrier or contract carrier or that it violated 52 Pa. Code §29.405. Rasier is a TNC operating in Pennsylvania pursuant to a license issued by this Commission under Chapter 26 of the Public Utility Code. Nevertheless, Rasier does not contest payment of the requested fine and is forwarding this amount in order to resolve and close this Complaint.
