**Re: Michael T. Jennings v. West Penn Power Company, Docket No. C-2018-3006031**

Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

I am writing as a *pro se* party and parent in the above-captioned matter to respectfully object to the **Reply Exceptions filed by FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“West Penn Rate District”) on March 28, 2025** (served by email and posted to the docket on Mar 31, 2025.)

On **March 20, 2025**, West Penn Power submitted a letter to the Commission stating that **it would not be filing Reply Exceptions**. That representation led me to believe the briefing process was complete.

Then, without any advance notice, West Penn Power reversed course and filed Reply Exceptions after all, **on what appears to be the last day permitted under 52 Pa. Code § 5.535(a)**. While the filing may fall within the technical deadline, the company’s reversal created **unnecessary surprise, confusion, and disadvantage**, particularly for a *pro se* party with full-time caregiving responsibilities.

**Even though Commission rules do not permit replies to Reply Exceptions, the prejudice lies in the fact that West Penn Power reversed its stated position at the last possible moment, after Petitioner reasonably believed the briefing process was over, and filed a final word Petitioner could not respond to.**

I respectfully request that the Commission **strike or disregard** West Penn Power’s Reply Exceptions based on this last-minute reversal and procedural prejudice it caused.

As a *pro se* party, I only recently learned that I could object and am submitting this letter to preserve the issue. Please consider this part of the formal record for any further review if necessary.
