On April 12, 2018, Elverson Water Company, Inc. (Elverson) filed the above-captioned document with the Public Utility Commission, which established a PENNVEST surcharge to provide for repayment of PENNVEST Loan No. 80190. On May 3, 2018, the Commission issued an Order (May 2018 Order) which permitted Elverson's proposed Supplement No. 9 to Tariff Water – Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 to become effective on June 1, 2018. Ordering Paragraph No. 7 of the May 2018 Order directed Elverson to file an annual reconciliation of the surcharge funds collected and disbursed each succeeding year the PENNVEST loan is outstanding.
