Dear Parties:

On June 11, 2025, Comcast Business Communications, LLC (Comcast) filed a motion for a 30-day extension to file a response to Ms. Hubbard's Formal Complaint. The original response is due June 20, 2025. In its motion, Comcast averred that the parties are seeking and are actively engaged in a non-adjudicative resolution to the case and that, in order to continue to facilitate that resolution, an extension was necessary.
