

**Response of John J. Logue, Pro Se**

**To Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC Petition to Reopen The Record**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW, HONORABLE JUDGE KATRINIA L. DUNDERDALE:

John J. Logue, Complainant appearing Pro Se, in this matter, wishes to file a strong objection to this Petition to Reopen the Record of the Proceedings held on April 23, 2025 for the following reasons:


1. While Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC (from here on "Peoples") contends both in its cover letter to the Petition and its formal Petition that it is "requesting that the record be reopened in this matter for "the limited purpose of correcting certain **typographical errors in the transcript**...." (emphasis mine), Appendix A attached to the Petition has fifty-nine (59) Proposed Corrections To Hearing Transcript. These "Proposed Corrections" are excerpts, completely out of context from the proceeding and following spoken words and unless Complainant pays for a complete transcript, cannot be understood as to its effect on the original, sworn testimony. These fifty-nine (59) Proposed Corrections are hardly "typographical errors".
2. It is Complainant's contention that these "typographical errors" are, in fact, Peoples' Senior Attorney, Mrs. Moore's attempt to alter the original, sworn, now determined by the Court Reporter to be clear and legible, testimony. This testimony was sworn, under oath and subject to cross examination by Complainant and should stand as stated during the hearing.
3. It would be completely unfair to allow Defendant, Peoples to, after the fact, alter testimony which was stated by their witnesses which may have been detrimental to Peoples' position. Judge Dunderdale followed up testimony many times with questions to clarify the record and during testimony, again, under oath, Mrs. Moore did not attempt to correct her witnesses' testimony.
4. Under Section 5.571 of the Public Utilities Commission's regulations it states, in relevant part, "(b) A petition to reopen must set forth clearly the facts claimed to constitute grounds requiring reopening of the proceeding, including material changes of fact or of

law alleged to have occurred since the conclusion of the hearing", Peoples Petition is devoid of any such contention.

**CONCLUSION**

WHEREFORE, Complainant, John Logue, appearing Pro Se, for the preceding reasons, strongly objects to the Petition Of Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC To Reopen The Record and respectfully requests that Administrative Law Judge Katrinia L. Dunderdale deny Peoples request to re-open the evidentiary record.


