Dear Secretary Homsher:

In accordance with the Commission's June 16, 2022 Order issued in the above-captioned docket (the "Order"), PECO Energy Company (PECO or the Company) hereby submits data regarding in program arrears payment arrangements for CAP customers, which are available under the following circumstances:

- Upon CAP reenrollment if off of CAP for more than 12 months;
- Upon receipt of a LIHEAP Crisis Grant;
- For accounts identified as PFA (Protection from Abuse);
- As part of a budget billing settlement¹; or
- As part of a reduced restoration agreement (but only if one or fewer broken payment arrangements).²

PECO's Customer Care & Billing (CC&B) system does not track the specific reasons for establishing a payment arrangement.³ To identify data regarding CAP customer payment arrangements, the Company performed an analysis of customer account activity that occurred

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within approximately 30 days of establishment of a payment arrangement. Based on this analysis, PECO inferred the following:
