Request for Information

Question #10 of the application.

The territory description is still not acceptable.

A.) Again, no mention of “but not limited to” should be mentioned anywhere in your territory. Take this ambiguous language out of your proposed service.

B.) Please revise the territory (The PUC is specifically interested in the counties from which operations will originate). To be clear the request should be to provide transportation from those specific counties, to points in Pennsylvania, and return, to allow you access to other counties.

Or you will need to comprehensibly show how you will be able to provide service to the wide range of territories (Blair and Allegheny counties) with limited resources. If for instance you were to receive a call from Allegheny County, to pick up and drop off someone 10 minutes away from their point of pick up, by regulation you would be unable to decline such a trip. As such, show that you have the infrastructure in place to provide service not only to Blair County but also Allegheny County, which is multiple counties away from your physical address.
