On May 7, 2025, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) received Enel X Advisory Services USA, LLC's (Enel X) Application for a Natural Gas Supplier (NGS) license. On May 27, 2025, the Commission served a Deficiency Secretarial Letter requesting missing or incomplete information. On June 11, 2025, Enel X filed responses to the Deficiency Secretarial Letter. In order for us to complete our analysis of Enel X's NGS Application, the Commission's Energy Industry Group requires answers to the attached questions.

Data Requests

1. Reference Application, Section 7.a, Financial Fitness – The Applicant indicated that because it proposes to operate solely as a broker, “there would be no applicable bonding requirements.” All Applicants, regardless of whether they propose to operate as a broker or supplier, are required to provide a bonding letter from each natural gas distribution company for the service territories in which they intend to operate. Please provide the missing documentation.
2. Reference Application, Section 5.a, b, and c. Compliance – the Applicant stated that it did not have any proceedings, actions or complaints to list. However, records indicate the following two proceedings may involve the Applicant, an affiliate, a predecessor of either, or a person identified in the Application:
 1. NHTSA Preliminary Investigation (PE24028) – Initiated on October 3, 2024, by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration’s Office of Defects Investigation.
 2. A proceeding filed on June 27, 2023, in the U.S. District Court for the District of New Jersey at Case No. 2:23-cv-03477.

If either of these above matters involve the Applicant, an affiliate, a predecessor of either, or a person identified in this Application, please resubmit responses to Section 5.a, b, and c disclosing the details of these proceedings. Applicants must disclose all proceedings, administrative or judicial, active or closed within the last five years, by name, subject, and citation. Please provide a statement as to the resolution or present status of any such proceedings listed. If these two proceedings do not involve the Applicant, an affiliate, a predecessor of either, or a person identified in the Application, please explicitly state so.

3. Reference Application, Section 7.b, Financial Fitness – Applicant provided minimal documentation to demonstrate its financial fitness. Please provide additional financial fitness documentation that may include:
 - Audited financial statements for the two most recent consecutive fiscal years.
 - Federal income tax filings for the two most recent consecutive years.
 - Bank account statements for at least the three most recent consecutive months.
4. Reference Application, Section 8.e, Technical Fitness –Please provide a professional resume including date ranges for the company’s chief officer, detailing relevant experience, credentials, and qualifications.
