Upon installation of a meter at the customer's service address by the Company, a customer will no longer be eligible for this rate schedule and will be charged a service charge based on the size of meter required to render adequate service along with a charge for consumption usage based upon the applicable metered rates in effect for the Residential Class.

The Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) shall not be applied to bills of water customers in Washington Township; this will remain in effect until an amended Long-Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan (LTIIIP) is filed and approved which includes Washington Township. Following the approval of an amended LTIIIP, the DSIC surcharge shall be applicable to water customers in Washington Township.
