Enclosed for filing is the executed **CONFIDENTIAL** Amendment Number Five (“Amendment 5”) to the Conservation Service Provider (“CSP”) Contract between PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”) and the CSP selected to implement the Residential Program under the Company’s Phase IV Energy Efficiency and Conservation (“EE&C”) Plan.

On March 31, 2021, PPL Electric filed the Residential CSP Contract with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) with the documentation required under the Commission’s *Phase IV Implementation Order*.<sup>1</sup> On May 6, 2021, Commission staff approved the Residential CSP Contract. On February 23, 2024, Commission staff approved Amendment Numbers 1 and 2 to the Residential CSP Contract. On May 29, 2024, PPL Electric filed Amendment Number 3 to the Residential CSP Contract. On July 24, 2024, PPL Electric filed the First Amendment 4 to the Residential CSP Contract. On September 6, 2024, Commission staff rejected the First Amendment 4. On November 8, 2024, Commission staff approved Amendment 3 to the Residential CSP Contract. On January 2, 2025, PPL Electric filed the Second Amendment 4 to the Residential CSP Contract. On February 6, 2025, Commission staff approved the Second Amendment 4 to the Residential CSP Contract.
