FINAL ORDER

In accordance with the provisions of Section 332(h) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §332(h), the decision of Administrative Law Judge Chad L. Allensworth dated May 22, 2025, has become final without further Commission action;

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Motion for Default Judgment filed by the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement against Dugan Construction at Docket No. C-2024-3051975 is granted.

2. That the Formal Complaint filed by the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement against Dugan Construction at Docket No. C-2024-3051975 is sustained.

3. That, within thirty (30) days of the entry date of this Opinion and Order, Dugan Construction shall remit \$7,500.00, payable by certified check or money order, to “Commonwealth of Pennsylvania” and sent to:

4. That a copy of this Opinion and Order shall be served upon the Financial and Assessment Chief, Office of Administrative Services.

5. That the Bureau of Administrative Services, Assessment Section shall monitor this matter for compliance.

6. That if Dugan Construction fails to make the payment required by Ordering Paragraph No. 3, above, within thirty (30) days of the entry date of this Order, it is further ordered that the Bureau of Administrative Services, Assessment Section, shall refer this matter to the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General for collection of the total set forth above and appropriate action.

7. That, after Dugan Construction remits the cumulative \$7,500.00 as required by Ordering Paragraph No. 3, the Secretary's Bureau shall mark Docket No. C-2024-3051975 as closed.
