**INTERIM ORDER  
ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE  
JOINT STIPULATION FOR ADMISSION OF EVIDENCE**

On June 16, 2025, the Pennsylvania-American Water Company (PAWC), Corner Water Supply and Service Corporation (Corner Water), the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA), and the Office of Small Business Advocate (collectively, Stipulating Parties) filed a Joint Stipulation for the Admission of Evidence (Joint Stipulation for Evidence) in the above-captioned proceeding.

The Stipulating Parties agreed to the authenticity of and admission of into the evidentiary record of the following statements and exhibits:

The Stipulation for Evidence was presented in conjunction with a Joint Petition for Approval of Unanimous Settlement (Settlement). Stipulation for Evidence ¶ 3. They further explained that copies of the statements and exhibits would be filed with the Commission’s Secretary’s Bureau upon approval of the Stipulation for Evidence. *Id.* at ¶ 5.

The Stipulating Parties requested that the Stipulation for Evidence be adopted and the exhibits and witness statements identified in the Stipulation for Evidence be admitted into the record on the terms and conditions set forth in the Stipulation for Evidence. They noted that certain filings contain information marked as “Confidential.” The Stipulating Parties requested that such materials be placed in non-public folders by the Secretary’s Bureau.

ORDER

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Joint Stipulation for the Admission of Evidence filed by the parties on June 16, 2025, is adopted and approved.

2. That the statements and exhibits listed in the Joint Stipulation for the Admission of Evidence are admitted into the record on the terms and conditions set forth in the Stipulation.
3. That, by **July 3, 2025**, a copy of each statement and exhibit admitted by this Order, unless previously filed, shall be filed with the Commission's Secretary's Bureau.
4. That all witness statements and exhibits, when filed pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 3, must be accompanied by a copy of this Order.
5. That all witness statements and exhibits, when filed pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 3, must be accompanied by a signed witness verification.
6. That all witness statements and exhibits, if "Confidential," must be properly marked by the sponsoring party when filed with the Commission's Secretary's Bureau.
7. That the Commission's Secretary's Bureau shall place all filings made pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 3 that are marked as "Confidential" in non-public folders, consistent with its normal practices.

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**JOINT STIPULATION FOR ADMISSION OF EVIDENCE**

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Pennsylvania-American Water Company (“PAWC”), Corner Water Supply and Service Corporation (“Corner Water”), the Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”), and the Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”), all active parties to the above-captioned proceeding (hereinafter, collectively referred to as the “Stipulating Parties”), file this Joint Stipulation for Admission of Evidence (“Stipulation”) in the above-captioned proceeding.<sup>1</sup> In support of the Stipulation, the Stipulating Parties represent as follows:

## **I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

1. The Stipulating Parties adopt the Procedural History as set forth in Paragraphs 1-22 of the Settlement.

## **II. STIPULATION**

2. The Stipulating Parties hereby jointly stipulate to the authenticity of and admission into the evidentiary record in this matter of the filings, statements, and exhibits listed below. All such filings, statements, and exhibits are authenticated by verifications from each supporting witness attached to the pre-served written testimony.

### **A. Pennsylvania-American Water Company Statements and Exhibits**

3. This Stipulation is presented by the Stipulating Parties in conjunction with the Settlement, which is intended to settle all issues in the above-captioned proceedings. If the Commission rejects or otherwise modifies the Settlement, the Stipulating Parties reserve their respective procedural rights to object to the admission of the above-referenced statements and exhibits, submit additional testimony and exhibits, and cross-examine witnesses at on-the-record evidentiary hearings.

4. This Stipulation is being presented in conjunction with the Settlement only to resolve issues in the above-captioned proceedings. Regardless of whether this Stipulation is approved, no adverse inference shall be drawn, nor shall prejudice result to any Stipulating Party in this or any future proceeding as a consequence of this Stipulation, or any of its terms or conditions.

5. Two copies of the foregoing statements and exhibits are being filed with the Commission's Secretary for inclusion in the official case record upon approval of this Stipulation. "Confidential" materials being filed with the Secretary's Bureau of the Commission are so marked and should be placed in non-public folders by the Secretary's Bureau.<sup>2</sup>

6. Attached hereto as **Appendix A** is a proposed "Order Granting Joint Stipulation for Admission of Evidence" for consideration by the Honorable Administrative Law Judge Emily I. DeVoe.
