The Bureau of Audits has reviewed PECO Energy Company's proposed Supplement No. 9 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 8 and the supporting rate computation submitted on June 20, 2025, to become effective on July 1, 2025. In the filing, the Company is proposing to reset its DSIC rate to 0.00% due to the Company's base rate case at Docket No. R-2024-3046931.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) rate for the three-month period of July 1, 2025 through September 30, 2025 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to become effective as filed.

The DSIC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter. Any subsequent submissions to the Commission related to this docketed case should reference Docket No. M-2025-3055854.
