1. In your verified statements you indicate that you have supplied copies of two W-2 forms to satisfy the experience criteria required by 52 Pa. Code §3.381(c)(1)(iii)(A)(II)(-1-); however, those forms do not appear in the record. Additionally, two W-2 forms do not fully establish employment in the industry for the required full two years. Because a W-2 only demonstrates that you were employed for at least two days over the course of two separate years (not the required approximate minimum 730 days) you will be required to provide additional evidence. Typically, a sworn and signed letter from your previous employer which indicates the dates of employment and the job responsibilities held will suffice. The letter should include the following paragraph:

I, _____, hereby state that the facts above set forth are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, and that I expect to be able to prove the same at a hearing held in this matter. I understand that the statements herein are made subject to the penalties of 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).

You may provide alternate means of evidence as well, but they will be reviewed on a case by case basis and they must provide concrete evidence of the required experience. Failure to provide the required evidence will result in the dismissal of the application.

2. Question #5 of the applicant's verified statements requires that you describe your hiring and employment policies. You are expected to provide a PLAN that satisfies all of the requirements of 52 Pa Code. Stating that your policies meet or exceed, "X, Y, or Z" does not demonstrate to the Commission what your policies are.

Even if there is only one driver the company is expected to maintain copies of reports to be available for review by the Commission. For this reason, it is required that the applicant provide the requested evidence of a compliant plan regardless of the number of drivers employed.

Please review the requirements of the following chapters of 52 Pa Code and provide a revised compliant plan for drivers which specifically addresses these issues.

- 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 391.11 - Age restrictions (minimum age).
- 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 391.25 - Driver history. (schedule)

RESPONSE:

"The purpose of this Hiring and Employment Policy is to establish consistent, fair, and legally compliant practices for recruiting, employing, and managing personnel within the company. We are committed to equal opportunity employment, ensuring that all hiring decisions are based on qualifications, skills, and experience without regard to race, gender, religion, age, disability, or any other protected status.

All job openings will be posted clearly with detailed descriptions of duties, required qualifications, and compensation. These openings will be advertised both internally and externally, including our website, social media, and through employee referrals. The minimum age for employment is 18, with driving positions requiring applicants to be at least 23 years old and to have a valid license, a clean driving record, and at least two years of professional driving experience. Background checks and pre-employment drug screening are mandatory for all positions. For safety-sensitive roles, random drug testing may also be conducted. The background checks will be conducted by Checkr (criminal record and driving history).

The hiring process will include standardized interviews to maintain fairness and consistency, and candidates will be scored based on predefined criteria. Once a candidate is selected, they will receive a conditional job offer outlining wage details, work schedule, and employment expectations. Upon acceptance, new hires will undergo orientation that includes training on company policies, safety procedures, and anti-discrimination and anti-harassment policies.

Employment classifications will be clearly defined as full-time, part-time, seasonal, or contract, with all necessary employment documents such as I-9 and W-4 completed and filed. Employees are expected to adhere to a professional code of conduct, which includes punctuality, appropriate attire, respectful behavior, and responsible use of company property. Substance use while on duty is strictly prohibited.

Compensation will be based on the role and market standards, with overtime pay provided for hours worked beyond 40 per week. Performance evaluations will occur semi-annually or annually to assess job performance, attendance, teamwork, and adherence to company policies. These evaluations may influence raises, promotions, or corrective actions.

A progressive discipline system will be followed, beginning with a verbal warning, followed by a written warning, possible suspension, and ultimately termination if necessary. Employees who voluntarily resign are encouraged to provide two weeks' notice. In the event of termination, final paychecks will be issued in compliance with state labor laws.

All employees must sign a statement acknowledging they have read and understood the company's policies. These policies will be reviewed annually and updated as needed, with any changes communicated clearly to all staff. This ensures that our company maintains a professional, respectful, and legally sound working environment.

Once hired, employees will be required to ensure all necessary documentation is completed at the time of each scheduled job. Employees will be required to keep Penske Maintenance form, and driver self-check form, on hand for the entirety of the job. Additionally, drivers will be required to log all hours driving, and take their mandatory breaks, to ensure compliance of a proper work/rest schedule. ”

4. What steps have you taken to ensure that the maintenance plan implemented by Penske meets the requirements of 67 Pa. Code 175, and how are you verifying that all inspections and services, etc. have been performed. Are you requesting and maintaining copies of each vehicle's service record prior to placing it into public service, and what physical inspections are you personally conducting on the vehicle prior to you placing it into public service? The responsibility of ensuring safety ultimately lies with the certificated carrier.

RESPONSE:

I have confirmed with Penske, that they will release their maintenance records to me for each vehicle I rent, at each time I rent them. This will allow me to go over the maintenance record, and ensure it is compliant with all requirements of the 67 Pa. Code 175. Additionally, I will keep my own maintenance records, and do my own check of the trucks upon each rental contract. It is also required, that the Penske agent on duty to a maintenance check on the vehicle before allowing it to be rented out. Any drivers that I have contracted, will be required to do the same. I will keep these maintenance records on file, along with my insurance and rental contracts from Penske for each booking. These documents will remain filed in my home office for 3 years after job completion.

Beyond the initial renting of the vehicle, if the vehicle is sued over the course of several days, the designated driver will be required to conduct a maintenance inspection before taking the vehicle on the road again.


