\*Global Logistic LLC will receive customer requests for transportation through a dedicated business phone line and a secure online reservation portal accessible 24/7. Clients will be able to schedule non-emergency medical transport in advance by calling our dispatch center or submitting trip details via our website. \*

\*Once a request is received, our centralized dispatch system will assign the trip to an available driver based on location, availability, and vehicle capacity. This system also generates real-time updates and trip logs for recordkeeping. \*

\*All drivers will be equipped with GPS-enabled smartphones that support voice and text communication, as well as a mobile dispatch app to receive assignments and updates instantly. This setup allows for real-time communication between dispatch staff and drivers throughout the service day, ensuring responsiveness to customer needs and traffic-related adjustments. \*

\*We will maintain an office in Chester County equipped with computers, internet, dispatching software, and customer service resources. Transportation records, trip logs, driver logs, and maintenance schedules will be stored digitally and securely, following all PUC documentation requirements. \*

## **5\*\*Driver Staffing and Safety Policy\*\***

> \*Global Logistic LLC plans to employ or contract with \*\*5 to 7 qualified drivers\*\* in the initial phase of operation. This number is based on anticipated service demand within Chester County and nearby counties such as Delaware, Lancaster, Montgomery, and Philadelphia. Our goal is to provide prompt, reliable, and safe transportation, and we believe this staffing level offers sufficient coverage while allowing for flexibility in scheduling and vehicle maintenance.\*

### **\*\*a. Hiring Standards:\*\***

Drivers must possess a \*\*valid Pennsylvania driver's license\*\*, have a minimum of \*\*three years of driving experience\*\*, and maintain a clean driving record. Preferred candidates will have previous experience transporting passengers, especially in medical or paratransit settings. We conduct \*\*in-person interviews\*\*, reference checks, and road tests prior to hiring.

### **\*\*b. Criminal Background Checks:\*\***

All prospective drivers must undergo a \*\*state and national criminal background check\*\* through the Pennsylvania State Police and FBI. This is conducted in compliance with PUC standards and includes fingerprinting. Individuals with violent felony convictions or offenses involving drugs, alcohol, or endangerment will not be considered.

### **\*\*c. Driver Training Program:\*\***

Drivers will complete a training program that includes:

- Defensive driving techniques
- Sensitivity and passenger assistance training
- Emergency procedures and first aid basics

- Safe operation of wheelchair-accessible vehicles (if applicable)
- Familiarization with HIPAA and client confidentiality protocols

**\*\*d. Driver License Checks:\*\***

We will conduct **\*\*initial and periodic license verification\*\*** through the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) system to ensure all drivers have valid, unrestricted licenses. Any violations or suspensions are grounds for disqualification or immediate review.

**\*\*e. Drug and Alcohol Policy:\*\***

Global Logistic LLC maintains a **\*\*zero-tolerance policy\*\*** for drug and alcohol use. All drivers must pass a **\*\*pre-employment drug screening\*\***, and we perform **\*\*random drug and alcohol testing\*\*** throughout the year. Any positive results or refusal to test will result in immediate termination.

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## **\*\*7. Vehicle Safety Program\*\***

### **\*\*a. Periodic Vehicle Maintenance Plan: \*\***

Global Logistic LLC will implement a strict preventative maintenance program for all service vehicles. Each vehicle will undergo a **\*\*comprehensive maintenance inspection every 5,000 miles or every 3 months\*\***, whichever comes first. In addition, drivers will conduct a **\*\*daily pre-trip inspection\*\*** covering brakes, tires, lighting systems, wipers, mirrors, fluid levels, lift/ramp operation (if applicable), and seat belts before the first passenger pick-up. All inspections and repairs will be logged using a digital fleet maintenance tracking system. Maintenance will be performed by **\*\*ASE-certified mechanics\*\*** at a reputable repair facility in Chester County.

**\*\*b. Compliance with Pennsylvania Vehicle Equipment Standards (67 Pa. Code, Chapter 175):** Global Logistic LLC will ensure that each vehicle is **\*\*inspected annually at a certified Pennsylvania Safety Inspection Station\*\***, as required by Chapter 175 regulations. Vehicles will be equipped with standard safety gear including fire extinguishers, first aid kits, reflective triangles, and fully functional restraints. Internal compliance checks will be performed **\*\*monthly\*\*** by the fleet manager using a checklist modeled on the PA inspection criteria. Any vehicle found noncompliant or with safety deficiencies will be **\*\*immediately removed from service\*\*** until corrected.

Based on our projected operating budget and financial position, we are confident that we can obtain and maintain the required insurance coverage as outlined by the PUC, including the necessary bodily injury/property damage liability limits and first-party medical benefits. We have verified that our selected insurer can electronically file the required Form E and Form H through the NIC Insurance Filing System, ensuring timely compliance upon approval of our application



# Financial Analysis and 4-Year Projection for Global Logistic

Chester County-Based NEMT Company

## Introduction

Global Logistic, a non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT) company based in Chester County, currently operates with \$36,000 in its business account and a fleet of four Ford Transit vans. This analysis provides a detailed financial overview and a 4-year projection of the company's growth, exploring expenses, revenue streams, and profit margins.

## Current Financial Situation

- Business Account Balance: \$36,000
- Assets: 4 Ford Transit vans, estimated value of \$35,000 each (total asset base: \$140,000)
- Primary Services: Medical transportation for patients requiring non-emergency transit.

## Assumptions for Financial Projections

- Revenue Growth: Annual growth rate of 15%, driven by marketing efforts and increased demand for NEMT services.


