Dear Judge Dunderdale:

Consistent with our June 18, 2025 correspondence,<sup>1</sup> I am now submitting a further status update in the above-captioned matter.

Following the last update, Pittsburgh Water has had several follow-up communications with Mr. Jones. During the last communication on June 27, 2025, Mr. Jones indicated that he intended to sign the agreement and submit his first settlement payment concurrently. However, to date, Pittsburgh Water has not received the executed Agreement nor any payment.

Accordingly, Pittsburgh Water respectfully requests an additional two-week extension to allow Mr. Jones the opportunity to finalize execution of the Agreement. If we do not receive the signed Agreement and payment within that time period, we anticipate requesting that the matter be rescheduled for hearing.
