The Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”), files this letter in lieu of petition for leave to withdraw our Intervention filed on April 17, 2025, in the above-referenced matter, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.94.

The OSBA and Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc.’s (“Aqua”), engaged in informal discovery and discussions. During these discussions, it was discovered that the proposed transaction encompasses only four small business and that Aqua’s purchase price is only \$75,000.00 which would not lead to any increased rates. As such, the OSBA does not wish to pursue this matter and is withdrawing its Intervention in this matter.

The OSBA informed the other parties and have received no objection to this withdrawal request.
