**Second Quarter 2025 Status Report**

Dear Secretary Homsher:

Pursuant to Appendix A of the Commission’s Ratification Order entered November 20, 2023<sup>1</sup> and the Commonwealth Court Order dated February 8, 2024<sup>2</sup>, this letter is intended to serve as the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Status Report of Pennsylvania-American Water Company (“Pennsylvania-American”) regarding its receivership of East Dunkard Water Authority (“EDWA”).

On April 29, 2025, Pennsylvania-American closed on the acquisition of EDWA and subsequently requested that the Commonwealth Court terminate its appointment as receiver of EDWA. By the attached Order dated June 13, 2025, the Commonwealth Court granted this request and directed Pennsylvania-American to submit a final accounting of receivership expenses within 90 days, which is September 11, 2025.

Pennsylvania-American will file one final quarterly Status Report after submitting the final accounting with the Commonwealth Court, no later than October 1, 2025.

**ORDER**

NOW, this 13<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2025, upon consideration of the Petition to Terminate Receivership, and there being no objection filed thereto, the Petition is GRANTED and the Court hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The receivership established by this Court’s Order of February 8, 2024, is hereby terminated effective as of the date of this Order.
2. Within ninety (90) days of the date of this Order, Pennsylvania-American Water Company shall compile and submit to this Court an accounting which includes the following elements:
  - a. the monetary Assets of the Authority received by the Receiver at commencement of the receivership;

- b. revenues, proceeds of grants or loans, accounts receivable accrued, or other Assets of the Authority received by the Receiver during the period of the receivership;
- c. grant or loan repayment obligations incurred by or on behalf of the Authority that were not paid off as part at Closing as part of the Outstanding Indebtedness;
- d. costs and expenses incurred by the Receiver for management, maintenance, operation, capital improvements, and corrective actions relating to the System and performance of the Receiver's obligations under the Receivership Order;
- e. the compensation paid or owed to the Receiver pursuant to Paragraph 4 of the Receivership Order;
- f. the proceeds of the Purchase Price utilized to pay off the Authority's Outstanding Indebtedness at Closing of the transaction; and
- g. the amount of net proceeds of the Purchase Price and remaining Assets of the Authority placed in the escrow accounts at Closing of the transaction; including with respect to such costs, expenses, and compensation, the amount of same that have been (i) paid from Authority funds and revenues during the course of the receivership, (ii) the amounts that have been advanced by the Receiver and charged to a deferred expense account as provided in the Order

of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission adopted November 9, 2023, and entered November 30, 2023 (the “Commission Order”); and (iii) the amounts to the extent known that remain outstanding and are anticipated to be submitted as claims against the Authority General Indemnity Escrow as provided under Section 2.4 of the Purchase Agreement.

3. The Court confirms its approval (as previously provided in Section 3 of the Court’s April 24, 2025 Order) for disposition of the net proceeds of the Purchase Price and remaining Assets of the Authority in accordance with the escrow fund arrangements, terms and procedures set forth in Section 10.4 of the Purchase Agreement and the Escrow Agreements executed pursuant thereto.
4. Jurisdiction over this matter is hereby retained pending receipt of an accounting of receivership expenses as described in the above paragraph 2.
