**Re: Petition of the Office of Consumer Advocate, the Office of Small Business Advocate, and the Pennsylvania Utility Law Project Requesting Initiation of a Proceeding on Federal Funding Opportunities for Utilities Under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act – Docket No. P-2022-3032929**

Dear Mr. Stahl:

By Commission Order entered March 21, 2023 (Order)<sup>1</sup>, it was directed that if a fixed public utility subject to the jurisdiction of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission receives any funding deriving from the federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), the utility shall file a report pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 504 by April 30 of each year to Docket No. P-2022-3032929, indicating the amount and date of the funding received during the preceding calendar year, and identifying the program(s) for which the funding is associated. The reporting requirement shall commence in 2023 and expire on May 1, 2027.

On April 23, 2025, AQUA Pennsylvania (AQUA) filed their report in accordance with ordering paragraph 2 of the Order. Upon review it appears AQUA is in substantial compliance with the Order.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition with the Commission within twenty (20) days after the date of this letter.
