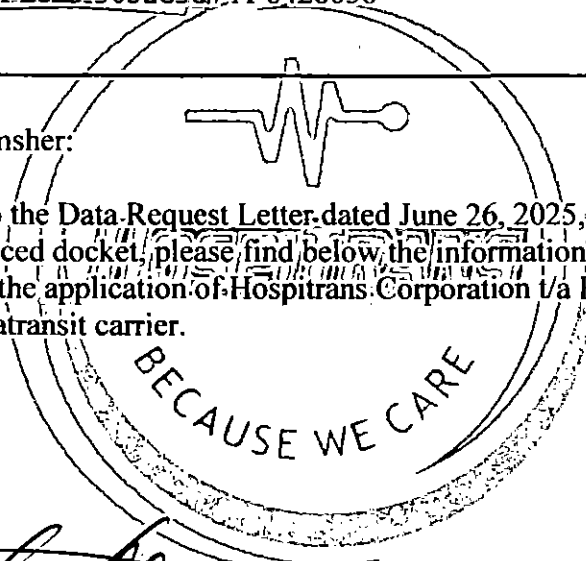

## **Response to Item 1**

### **Proposed Service Territory**

Hospitrans Corporation proposes the following service territory:

“Paratransit service from points in the counties of Berks, Lancaster, Lebanon, Schuylkill, Lehigh, and Montgomery, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.”

This means that Hospitrans Corporation intends to originate service exclusively within the above-listed counties and provide transportation to any location within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, including return trips from those destinations to the counties of origin.

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## **Response to Item 2**

### **Vehicle Ownership**

Hospitrans Corporation confirms that all vehicles operating under the paratransit authority will be owned and insured by Hospitrans Corporation.

Hospitrans Corporation plans to maintain a company-owned fleet that will include:

- Sedans
- Minivans
- Stretcher vehicles (ambulette)

All vehicles will be titled, registered, and insured under the name Hospitrans Corporation. No vehicles will be independently owned or operated under this authority.

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## **Response to Item 3**

### **Compliance System – Requirements under Title 52, Chapter 29**

Hospitrans Corporation has developed policies and procedures to ensure compliance with the requirements set forth in Title 52, Chapter 29 of the Pennsylvania Code, including §§ 29.503, 29.504, and 29.505, as follows:

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### **a) Age Restrictions (§29.503)**

Hospitrans Corporation will employ only drivers who are at least 21 years of age and hold a valid driver's license issued by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. All drivers must submit proof of age and licensing prior to employment.

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### **b) Driver History (§29.504)**

- Prior to employment, Hospitrans Corporation will obtain a three-year Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) from PennDOT for each driver applicant.
  - Drivers will be disqualified if they have three (3) or more moving violations within the past three years or any major violations, including but not limited to:
    - Driving under the influence (DUI)
    - Reckless driving
    - Driving with a suspended license
  - Driver records will be reviewed annually to ensure continued compliance.

### **c) Criminal History (§29.505)**

- All driver applicants will undergo state and federal criminal background checks.
  - Hospitrans Corporation will not employ individuals with convictions for:
    - Violent crimes
    - Sexual offenses
    - Fraud or theft
    - Crimes involving vulnerable populations
    - Other offenses that may compromise the safety of passengers
  - Criminal background checks will be repeated every two (2) years for all active drivers.

### **d) Vehicle Maintenance and Inspections**

- All vehicles will be maintained in safe operating condition following:
    - Manufacturer's recommended service schedules
    - The required annual Pennsylvania State Safety Inspections
  - Daily pre-trip inspections will be conducted using checklists covering:
    - Brakes, lights, tires, steering, seatbelts, and proper operation of any specialized equipment (e.g., wheelchair lifts)
  - Records of inspections, repairs, and maintenance will be maintained at Hospitrans Corporation's business office for a minimum of two (2) years.

### **e) Driver Training**

Hospitrans Corporation will provide all drivers with both initial and annual training on:

- Defensive driving and safe vehicle operation
  - Passenger assistance techniques for individuals with disabilities
  - Proper securement of wheelchairs and mobility devices
  - Emergency response procedures
  - Customer service and HIPAA compliance
- 

### **f) Annual Reporting Compliance**

Hospitrans Corporation acknowledges that all certificated intrastate revenue is subject to annual reporting and assessment under the Commission's regulations. Hospitrans Corporation will maintain complete financial records and will submit:

- Annual reports of intrastate gross operating revenues
- Payment of assessments as determined by the Commission

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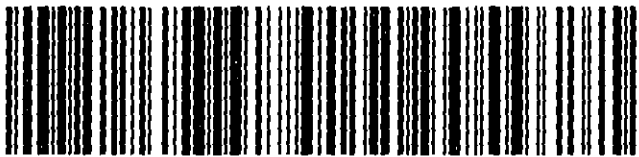
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
