Enclosed for filing on behalf of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation ("PPL Electric") is a Damage Release between PPL Electric and Larksville Borough located in Luzerne County, Pennsylvania. This agreement is being filed pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S.A. § 507.

PPL Electric has agreed to pay Larksville Borough for the cost of a calcium chloride application to Hill Lane in order to minimize dust pollutants caused by PPL Electric's heavier than normal use of Hill Lane during an ongoing 230 kV rebuild project.

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.11, the enclosed document is to be deemed filed on July 11, 2025, which is the date it was filed electronically using the Commission's E-filing system.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Larksville Borough, of 211 East State Street, Larksville, Pennsylvania 18704, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand One Hundred Thirty Dollars and 80/100 (\$1,130.80) in hand paid by **PPL Electric Utilities Corporation**, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release, quitclaim and forever discharge the said PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, its respective officers, agents, employees, successors, assigns and all persons or entities, whether or not named herein, who may be jointly or severally liable, of and from all suits, claims, demands, actions, damages and claims for damages or contribution whatsoever arising out of or resulting from any injury, loss or damage that may have been caused **to Hill Lane, in Larksville Borough, and for calcium chloride application across said road** in the Borough of Larksville, County of Luzerne, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by reason of the construction, reconstruction and/or maintenance by the said PPL Electric Utilities Corporation of its overhead and/or underground electric line facilities, upon, over, under and across said property to the day of the date of these presents. Owner shall maintain in the strictest confidence the terms of this Agreement, including the amount payable hereunder.

This Agreement is between a public utility and a municipal corporation and is therefore subject to Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") review pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S.A. § 507. The Effective Date of this Agreement shall be the later of i) thirty (30) days from the date that PPL submits the Agreement to the PUC; or ii) if the PUC opens an investigation of the Agreement, on the date the PUC approves the Agreement.
