On July 11, 2025, UGI Utilities, Inc. (UGI Utilities) and Mountaineer Gas Company, UGI Energy Services, LLC, and AmeriGas Propane, Inc. (collectively UGI Affiliates) amended Affiliated Interest Agreement was accepted for filing and docketed with the Public Utility Commission. In order for us to complete our analysis of your application, the Energy Industry Group requires answers to the attached question(s).
