PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS' MOTION TO CONTINUE

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.15, Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”) hereby files this Motion to Continue the evidentiary hearing in this matter, which is scheduled for Wednesday, July 30, 2025. In support of this Motion, PGW states as follows:

1. By notice dated May 30, 2025, the Commission scheduled a hearing in this matter for Wednesday, July 30, 2025 at 10:00 a.m., before Administrative Law Judge Eranda Vero.
2. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.231(a) and the Prehearing Order issued in this matter, PGW is working with the Complainant to reach a resolution in this matter.
3. Part of Ms. Elliot’s complaint involves high-bill/incorrect usage allegations.
4. PGW is working to schedule a time to exchange and test Ms. Elliot’s current meter.
5. PGW and the Complainant need additional time to attempt to resolve this matter.
6. PGW has spoken with Ms. Elliot via phone to discuss this request to continue the hearing.
7. Ms. Elliot has stated that she has no objection to PGW’s Motion and that she agrees that additional time to test her meter and discuss the results would be beneficial.
