

COMES NOW, Shasta Patrice Brown, Executor for the Ren-Ira Michal Zuri-El Private Estate

("Claimant"), and respectfully gives notice that PECO Energy Company and the Pennsylvania

Public Utility Commission ("PUC") are now in uncontested default, dishonor, and commercial

breach, demanding immediate lawful remedy as follows:

I. FACTUAL RECORD AND GROUNDS FOR RELIEF

1. **Background:** Claimant lawfully opened or assumed three PECO accounts (two merged, one closed) since 2021. PECO's mismanagement, wrongful billing, and unauthorized credit reporting gave rise to repeated injury.
2. **Subpoena & RTKL:** On May 15, 2024, Claimant issued a lawful subpoena under 52 Pa. Code § 5.421 and a Right-to-Know Law (RTKL) request for all relevant records. PECO and the PUC failed to comply by the deadline of June 27, 2025.
3. **Estoppel & Quo Warranto:** An Estoppel Notice and Writ of Quo Warranto were served on Respondents' counsel. Both stand unrebutted, creating estoppel by acquiescence.

4. **Form 56:** Claimant filed IRS Form 56 with PECO, the PUC, and the IRS to establish fiduciary standing as private Executor.
5. **Fee Schedule & Administrative Remedy:** Claimant served a notarized, certified Private Fee Schedule since 2023. Respondents failed to rebut any clause, establishing contractual consent under the Law Merchant.
6. **Continuous Injury:** PECO used Claimant's copyrighted name six (6) times reporting to credit bureaus without consent, committed three (3) misuse events of the account, merged accounts without permission, and forced unauthorized correspondence.
7. **Communications & Calls:** Claimant sent twenty-nine (29) lawful notices and emails to PECO directly, two (2) to Anthony Costello, and made three (3) phone calls demanding cure.
8. **PUC Breach of Fiduciary Duty:** The PUC failed its Constitutional oath to protect the unidentified beneficiaries of the Commonwealth (see Pa. Const. Art. I, § 1). The PUC's silence and inaction amount to collusion and dishonor.
9. **ADA Reservation:** Claimant clarifies that any ADA reference pertains solely to functional disability in comprehending complex administrative law — not incompetence or diminished capacity.

II. CONTROLLING LAW & PRECEDENT

- **Silence is Acquiescence:** United States v. Prudden, 424 F.2d 1021 (5th Cir. 1970).
- **Affidavit Stands as Truth:** Zobel v. Williams, 457 U.S. 55 (1982).
- **Subpoena Enforcement:** Lefkowitz v. Turley, 414 U.S. 70 (1973); 52 Pa. Code § 5.421.

- **Liquidated Damages Valid:** Aetna Cas. & Surety Co. v. Commonwealth, 489 Pa. 358 (Pa. 1980).
- **Default Judgment:** Pa.R.C.P. 1037(b); Brooks v. BAC Home Loans, 43 A.3d 983 (Pa. Super. Ct. 2012).
- **PUC Oath:** Pennsylvania Constitution, Art. VI § 3; Art. I Bill of Rights.
- **FCRA Misreporting:** 15 U.S.C. § 1681s-2.

III. COMMON LAW AFFIDAVIT OF ADMINISTRATIVE EXHAUSTION, DISHONOR & ESTOPPEL

I, Shasta Patrice Brown, Executor for the Ren-Ira Michal Zuri-El Private Estate, hereinafter "Affiant," solemnly declare under penalty of perjury:

1. Affiant opened or assumed three PECO Energy Company accounts in or around 2021, including accounts merged without consent.
2. Affiant pursued full administrative remedy for all billing errors, unauthorized charges, credit damage, and misreporting.
3. Commercial instruments including 1099-A forms were lawfully tendered and dishonored without rebuttal.
4. Affiant filed Form 56 with PECO, the PUC, and the IRS to secure fiduciary standing.
5. A RTKL request and lawful subpoena were served and dishonored beyond statutory deadlines.
6. An Estoppel Notice and Writ of Quo Warranto were served unrebutted, confirming estoppel by acquiescence.
7. PECO and the PUC failed fiduciary duties and remain in dishonor.

8. By continued silence, dishonor, and non-performance, all terms stand as binding truth in commerce and law.
9. PECO continues adverse credit reporting in violation of 15 U.S.C. § 1681s-2.
10. Affiant has exhausted administrative remedy; all unrebutted claims, tenders, notices, and the notarized Fee Schedule are binding.

FURTHER AFFIANT SAYETH NAUGHT.

3. Removal of adverse credit reporting.
4. Written confirmation within seven (7) calendar days.

Non-compliance triggers court action, equitable liens, and garnishment.

VI. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

Claimant expressly reserves all rights, waives none.

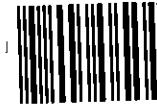
