MOTOR CARRIER COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “PUC”) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement – Motor Carrier Division hereby represents as follows:

1. That JORGE GARCIA, T/A PENN LIMO, Respondent, maintains its principal place of business at 424 Waupelani Drive, Apt A32, State College, PA 16801
2. That on April 30, 2025, PUC Enforcement Supervisor Ernest Snyder was assigned a complaint about PENN LIMO operating without PUC authority. Supervisor Snyder discovered, through research Respondent transportation services mlisted on several websites, which included several pictures of luxury vehicles.
3. That during that investigation Supervisor Snyder also discovered that on August 6, 2024, in response to another complaint filed, Respondent was advised to cease and desist from transporting passengers for compensation and the consequences of failure to obtain authority/certificate granted by the PUC.
4. That on May 14, 2025, Supervisor Snyder contacted the Respondent’s business requesting transportation from State College, PA to Altoona, PA. A carrier representative stated Supervisor Snyder would be required to reserve the vehicle for a minimum of 4 hours at \$150 per hour for a total of \$600. The representative stated that reservation would be confirmed once payment was sent via text message. Supervisor Snyder explained that due to concern about being scammed he did not want to make payment in that manner. Carrier responded that was the only way to reserve the trip.
5. That Respondent, by advertising passenger transportation services by vehicle for compensation without obtaining/holding a certificate/authority from the Commission, has violated 66 Pa. Code §1101; 1102(a). The penalty for this violation as is \$1,000.00.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby requests that the Commission fine JORGE GARCIA, T/A PENN LIMO, the SUM of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for the illegal activity described in this Complaint and order such other remedy as the Commission may deem to be appropriate.
