Application of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania for approval of the alteration of the crossing where Killarney Drive crosses, below grade, a single track owned by Wheeling & Lake Erie Railway Company (DOT 472 796 B) by the installation of an underground 8 inch plastic gas line in the Borough of Castle Shannon, Allegheny County.

To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated February 28, 2025, we directed the alteration of the subject crossing where Killarney Drive crosses, below grade, a single track of Wheeling & Lake Erie Railroad Company (DOT 472 796 B) in the Borough of Castle Shannon, Allegheny County. All work at the subject crossing is to be completed on or before March 31, 2026.

By letter-petition received on May 13, 2025, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania submitted revised plans for the subject alteration, a copy of which was served on all the parties of record. The plans are identified as "EXHIBIT A," and consist of two (2) sheets. No objections to the plans have been received.

The Commission issues this Secretarial Letter in accordance with Section 2702 of the Public Utility Code and approves the revised plans received on May 13, 2025, THEREFORE:

1. Paragraph 2 of our Secretarial Letter dated February 28, 2025, which reads as follows, to wit:

"2. The crossing where Killarney Drive crosses, below grade, a single track of Wheeling & Lake Erie Railway Company (DOT 472 796 B) in Castle Shannon Borough, Allegheny County be altered generally in accordance with the plan hereby entitled: "EXHIBIT A" consisting of two (2) sheets submitted to the Commission on January 14, 2025; which plans are made part hereof and is hereby approved except insofar as they may relate to the division of work, deletion of work, or the allocation of costs and expenses incident to the installation of the project."

be and is hereby modified to read:

2. The crossing where Killarney Drive crosses, below grade, a single track of Wheeling & Lake Erie Railway Company (DOT 472 796 B) in Castle Shannon Borough, Allegheny County be altered generally in accordance with the plan hereby entitled: “EXHIBIT A” consisting of two (2) sheets submitted to the Commission on May 13, 2025; which plans are made part hereof and is hereby approved except insofar as they may relate to the division of work, deletion of work, or the allocation of costs and expenses incident to the installation of the project.

2. In all respects not inconsistent herewith, our Secretarial Letter dated February 28, 2025, remains in full force and effect.

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.

All formal documents must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission. Documents must be eFiled, mailed or hand delivered. All filings should be addressed to the Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. The Commission will not accept documents delivered by fax or by e-mail. Parties are encouraged to file formal documents by eFiling with the Secretary of the Commission by opening an eFiling account through the Commission’s website (the account is free of charge) and accepting eservice at <https://www.puc.pa.gov/filing-resources/efiling/>.

If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
