Dear Secretary Homsher:

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.82, T-Mobile USA, Inc. files this uncontested letter petition for leave to withdraw without prejudice the Petition for Interim Emergency Order filed on July 22, 2025. Section 1.82 of the Commission's regulations allows for withdrawal of an uncontested pleading by leave if no party objects to withdrawal within 10 days. *Id.* ("A party that desires to terminate an uncontested matter or proceeding before final decision by the Commission or otherwise desires to withdraw a submittal or pleading, shall file a petition for leave to withdraw the appropriate document. If no party objects to the petition within 10 days of service, the matter may be stricken by the Commission or by the presiding officer."). Here, no party has contested the July 22, 2025 Petition or filed any responsive document thereto. T-Mobile has conferred with Everstream Solutions, LLC and Zito Media and both parties have permitted counsel for T-Mobile to represent they do not oppose withdrawal of July 22, 2025 Petition.

T-Mobile withdraws the July 22, 2025 Petition in furtherance of settlement, which is promoted by Commission policy. 52 Pa. Code Section 5.231 ("It is the policy of the Commission to encourage settlements.").

T-Mobile further requests that the July 31, 2025 telephonic hearing scheduled for the July 22, 2025 Petition be cancelled immediately. T-Mobile notes that it is not withdrawing its Protest to Everstream's application pending at A-2025-3053757 and is not requesting any change to the August 7, 2025 prehearing conference scheduled in that matter.
