Request for Information

- 1.) For the Public Utility Commission to get a better understanding of your overall business concept.
  - A.) Please clarify as to who will be paying for the transportation services such as the individual rider or a school district.
  
  - B.) Please give an explanation if you are/will be under contract transporting school children with a school district for all your proposed trips.
  
  - C.) If applicable, provide signed contracts with your response.
  
- 2.) Question #10 of the application.

Terms such as “surrounding areas” are unacceptable and insufficiently specific. The description of the authority needs to have clear boundaries and is typically requested by county/counties only, keeping with the Commission’s criteria in mind. Please revise your request or verify that the below example is what you now intend.

**Example:** *To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, between points in Luzerne County.*

3.) Question # 5 of the Verified Statement

Provide compliant policies that satisfy the requirements of 52 Pa Code with revision to the specific chapters below. Please review Title 52 information online, which may be accessed at [www.pacode.com](http://www.pacode.com).

A.) § 29.503. Age restrictions. (minimum age): Will drivers be at least a certain minimum age?

B.) § 29.504. Driver History. How often will a driver license checks be done?

C.) § 29.505. Criminal history. How often will record checks be done?

D.) § 29.506. Alcohol prohibition and § 29.507. Controlled substance prohibition. Who will be conducting drug/alcohol tests.

4.) Question # 5 of the Verified Statement.

Please clarify:

A.) On what schedule will oil changes and tune-ups be done?

B.) Are you planning to conduct pre-trip inspections? Give a sample of the inspection checklists.

5.) Financial Position.

A.) Please verify that all assets and debts listed (for example: vehicle loan balances/vehicle asset value, etc.) in the submitted Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet) are held by the applicant (Compai Transportation LLC) and not the member(s). Any property listed MUST be held to the company which is applying for authority. In your submission, you provided information which states the company owns land/building(s). We need to know if the applicant is co-mingling its assets/debts, which is not permissible. If you have erroneously comingled the applicant's company assets/debts with those of the company member's personal assets/debts, then a revised Balance Sheet with an explanation of what was changed and why is required.

- Please ensure that the figures provided are accurate as of the date provided on the balance sheet, and that all figures provided are based on the best available information. The information is to be exact and should not include estimates or approximations when accurate numbers are available.
- Any assets which may need transferred to the applicant should happen prior to adding them to the balance sheet.

B.) At this point it is expected that the applicant's account is now filled and ready to commence operations with the ability to provide safe, efficient, and reliable service. Please provide supporting documentation for the balance sheet. Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements or notarized/official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers (with current contact information) in the name of "Compai Transportation LLC". (account numbers may be redacted).

C.) Submit proof of ownership of the claimed vehicles and the land/building, such as registrations, titles, purchase agreements, etc. All proof must be in the name of "Compai Transportation LLC".

**Note:** It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged.
