MOTOR CARRIER COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “PUC”) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement – Motor Carrier Division hereby represents as follows:

1. That CONCEORD LIMOUSINE, Respondent, maintains its principal place of business at 2728 Mt Carmel Avenue, Glenside, PA 19038.

2. That Respondent obtained taxi authority on August 11, 1997, and limousine service on November 22, 2021, by this Commission at Application Docket No. A-00113582, PUC Utility Code 640504.

3. That on June 5, 2025, PUC Enforcement Officer Reynoldo Pierluisse conducted an annual inspection on Monument Road, Philadelphia, PA of a 2014 Ford Sedan, bearing PA registration number TX49906, the having vehicle identification number ending in the last 4 digits 5833, driven by Richard Cutler. The following violations were found:

- a. Taxicab did not have the attached dome light, illuminated at the time of the inspection, in violation of 52 Pa. Code §29.314(d). The penalty for this violation is \$100.
- b. Taxi fares were not posted in a visible area in the vehicle, in violation of 52 Pa. Code §29.316(a)(1)(i). The penalty for this violation is \$50.

4. That during the inspection Officer Pierluisse noted on the Driver Vehicle Compliance Report (“DVCR”) that the consumer information decal was posted, but the required identifying information was blank in violation of 52 Pa. Code §29.318. Officer Pierluisse is issued a warning in lieu of a penalty for this violation.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby requests that the Commission fine the Respondent CONCORD LIMOUSINE, INC., the sum of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for the illegal activity described in this Complaint and order such other remedy as the Commission may deem to be appropriate.
