**PREHEARING ORDER**

An in-person hearing on the Petition for Interim Emergency Order is scheduled for **Wednesday, August 6, 2025, at 10:00 a.m.** on the 4th Floor, Hearing Room # 4125 (Jefferson Room,) 801 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19107.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That if you intend to present any documents for my consideration, you must bring one copy for the other party, one copy for me and two copies for the court reporter to the hearing. A attachments to your Complaint or Petition are not admitted into the record unless submitted separately in accordance with this paragraph.

2. That if you are an individual, you may either represent yourself or have an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania represent you. However, if you are a partnership, corporation, trust, association, joint venture, other business organization, trust, trustee, legal representative, receiver, agency, governmental entity, municipality or other political subdivision, you must have an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania represent you in this proceeding. Unless you are an

attorney, you may not represent someone else. Attorneys shall comply with the Commission's appearance requirements. 52 Pa. Code § 1.24(b).

3. That requests for a change of the scheduled hearing date will not be granted absent agreement of all parties and where good cause exists. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b). Requests for a change of hearing date must be submitted in writing and e-mailed to me and all parties of record. My address is: [evero@pa.gov](mailto:evero@pa.gov).

4. That a copy of anything filed with the Secretary or submitted shall be sent directly to the presiding officer at the e-mail address listed above.

5. That the Petitioner has the burden of proving that the Petitioner's right to relief is clear; the need for relief is immediate; the injury would be irreparable if relief is not granted; and that the relief requested is not injurious to the public interest. 52 Pa. Code §3.7; Section 332(a) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §332(a).

6. THAT IF A PARTY FAILS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE HEARING, THE HEARING WILL PROCEED WITHOUT THAT PARTY AND A DECISION MAY BE ENTERED AGAINST THAT PARTY.

7. This hearing is a formal proceeding and will be conducted in accordance with the Commission's rules of practice and procedure. 52 Pa. Code Chapters 1, 3 and 5.

8. That Respondent is required to contact Complainant to discuss informally the possible settlement of this case as soon as possible. Commission policy is to encourage settlements. 52 Pa. Code § 5.231(a).
