Proposal for the Summer 2025 GSR-1 Full Requirements and Block RFP

Dear Ms. Colaizzi:

On July 31, 2025, UGI Utilities, Inc. (UGI) filed the results of its Request for Proposals (RFP) Process and Rules for the Summer 2025 Solicitation for provider of last resort service. The filing includes proposed bid results for a 12-month full requirements power RFP for Residential and Small Commercial and Industrial customers who receive default service from UGI during the period of December 1, 2025, through November 30, 2026. The filing also includes a solicitation for a 60-month block product (7x24(around the clock)) during the period of September 1, 2025, through August 31, 2030.

This filing was submitted in accordance with UGI's Default Service Plan V RFP Process and Rules filed on May 31, 2024, as part of a Joint Petition for Non-Unanimous Settlement. The RFP Process and Rules were approved as modified by the Settlement in the Commission's Order, entered February 20, 2025, at Docket Nos. P-2024-3049343 and G-2024-3049351.

UGI requests that the Commission approve the bid results of the Summer 2025 Solicitation on or before August 1, 2025.

Further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, since the results of the Summer 2025 Solicitation appear to have been conducted in accordance with the RFP Process and Rules as approved by the Commission.

Therefore, we direct UGI to disclose the results of this Summer 2025 Solicitation in accordance with the Commission's Secretarial Letter in Re: Disclosure of Default Service Solicitation Results and Creation of a Default Service Rate Calculation Model, issued October 12, 2010, at Docket No. M-2009-2082042.
