On July 17, 2025, Energy Center Harrisburg LLC (ECH) filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission), pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §§ 2102, *et seq.*, the above-referenced Affiliated Interest Agreement (AIA or Agreement). In order for us to complete our analysis of your application, the Energy Industry Group requires answers to the attached questions.

TUS-1. The predecessor to this AIA, approved on August 25, 2011, between NRG Energy Center Harrisburg LLC and NRG Harrisburg Cooling LLC at Docket No. G-2010-2212422, established a monthly billing rate of \$39,500, charged by NRG Energy Center Harrisburg LLC to NRG Harrisburg Cooling LLC. Given the economic impact of inflation and the general rise in operations, maintenance, and other costs since 2011, please provide a detailed justification for the proposed reduced monthly charge of \$33,444, approximately \$6,000, or 15% less than the previously approved rate.

To assist in our review, please address the following:

- Scope of Services: Has the scope or quantity of services provided changed in a manner that justifies the reduction in monthly charges? If so, please describe the changes in scope or service level in detail.
- Cost Breakdown: Please provide a breakdown of the proposed \$33,444 monthly charge by service category (e.g., operations, maintenance, administrative, utilities, etc.). Include any supporting calculations, assumptions, or cost allocation methodologies used to derive the total monthly charge.

TUS-2. Explain all revenue and ratemaking implications that the Agreement may have.

TUS-3. Please clarify whether the proposed Agreement will result in any additional costs to ECH that are not explicitly addressed or reimbursed under the terms of the Affiliated Interest Agreement (AIA). If such costs are anticipated, please identify them and explain how they will be treated for both accounting and ratemaking purposes.
