Request for Information

- 1.) How does this business distinguish itself from the work your company performs that is not under the jurisdiction of the PUC? You have not clearly explained the difference in proposed services from the work that is exempt from PUC Authority. Please explain.
- 2.) Territory is traditionally given my county name. Are Allegheny and Beaver the only counties from which you intend to ORIGINATE service? Typical Paratransit authority allows for travel from points in those counties, to points in Pennsylvania, and return. Your specific counties of trip origination must be named in your operating authority, please advise.
- 3.) The responses to questions 5(a), 5(b), 5(c), 5(d) and 5(e) of the verified statements are insufficient. Title 52 Pa. Code § 29 provides detailed requirements. Please provide a system which incorporates code specified compliance requirements: Google Title 52 and you can easily find the specific answers in regard to frequency and retention of necessary records for the hiring of drivers for PUC services.. Each of your answers to sections of this question were insufficient:
 - § 29.503. Age restrictions.
 - § 29.504. Driver history
 - § 29.505. Criminal history.
