- 1.) You failed to adequately answer all aspects of question #5 of the Verified Statement of Applicant. Please review Title 52 Pa Code §29.501-509 Driver Regulations to see what is required of motor carriers.
 - a. Your system for conducting criminal background checks; (Title 52 Pa Code §29.505 – Criminal History)
 - i. How will you maintain records (record retention) of the criminal background checks performed? The answer provided in your previous response to our data request did not fully comply with the regulations found at Title 52 Pa Code §29.505(a)(4)

RESPONSE: Prior to a driver operating a vehicle in Applicant’s service, the Applicant shall obtain and review a criminal history record from the Pa State Police and every other state in which the driver has resided in the previous twelve months. Following that initial check, Applicant shall review criminal history records from the Pa State Police at least every two years from the last criminal history check.


Records received electronically will be saved in a secure folder on a computer or hard drive at Applicant’s main location. Hard copies of records will be maintained in a secure filing cabinet at the primary location. All copies of the criminal history records shall be kept for at least three years from the date they were obtained.

- b. Your system for conducting driver license/history checks; (Title 52 Pa Code §29.504 – Driver History)
 - i. How will you maintain records (record retention) of such checks? The answer provided in your previous response to our data request did not fully comply with the regulations found at Title 52 Pa Code §29.504(a)(3). Please provide a policy for how driver license/history checks will be maintained by the carrier that complies with the aforementioned regulation.

RESPONSE: Prior to a driver operating a vehicle in Applicant’s service, they will be required to provide a copy of their driving history from the appropriate agency in every state in which they held a license during the previous three years. Following that initial check, Applicant shall obtain a driver’s history at least once every 12 months from the most recent report. This shall be supplemented by Applicant’s insurance carrier which also conducts checks of the driver histories.

Electronic records will be maintained in a secure online storage at Applicant’s primary location. Hard records will be maintained securely at Applicant’s primary location. All Driver history records shall be kept for at least two years from the date they were obtained.
