Dear Judge Vero:

PBF Holding Company LLC ("PBF") does not believe it should be required appear or participate in the Emergency Hearing on August 6, 2025. Although PBF is a Complainant in Docket No. C-2025-3053018, it did not join in or participate in the Petition for Interim Emergency Relief filed by Lucknow-Highspire Terminals, LLC and Sheetz, Inc. on July 29, 2025 (the "Petition").

PBF supports the Petition and the relief requested therein. PBF has also been affected by Laurel's outages because dates were changed unexpectedly, and notice was provided at the last minute. However, the impact on PBF did not rise to the level required to meet the burden associated with an emergency petition. As a result, PBF elected not to join in the Petition.

PBF does not consider itself to be a party to the Petition, does not plan to intervene, provide or sponsor a witness or exhibit, or otherwise participate in the hearing. We have no relevant evidence to offer. Further, PBF views the Petition as a separate matter from the Complaint filed in C-2025-3053018.

PBF recognizes that the Hearing Notice provides that: "You may lose the case if you do not come to this hearing and present facts on the issues raised." PBF also notes the all-capitals warning in Paragraph 6 of the Pre-Hearing Order. Nevertheless, as PBF did not join in the Petition, it should not be required to attend the hearing or present facts. However, PBF does not want to prejudice the Petitioners, or PBF, in any way or have PBF's absence somehow attributed to and used against the Petitioners.
