**JOINT STATUS REPORT**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

Pursuant to the Commission’s March 4, 2025 Order, Complainant, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”), and Respondent Repsol Oil and Gas USA, LLC (“Repsol”), by and through their respective undersigned counsel, file the within Joint Status Report and state as follows:

1. I&E initiated the above-captioned enforcement proceeding with the filing of a Complaint against Repsol on February 7, 2025. (*See Compl.*)
2. On February 13, 2025, Repsol filed an Expedited Unopposed Motion to Stay Proceedings, requesting that the Commission stay this proceeding through final disposition of a parallel matter then-pending before the Pennsylvania Supreme

Court, namely, an appeal from the Pennsylvania Commonwealth Court docketed as *Repsol Oil & Gas USA, LLC v. Pa. Pub. Util. Comm'n*, No. 62 MAP 2024 (Pa.).

3. The Commission granted Repsol's Motion by Order of March 4, 2025, staying all deadlines in this action pending resolution of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court appeal and tasking the parties to file a joint status report to the docket in this proceeding within 14 days of final disposition of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court appeal.

4. On July 22, 2025, the Pennsylvania Supreme Court entered a *per curiam* Order affirming the Commonwealth Court's decision without opinion. *See Repsol Oil & Gas USA, LLC v. Pa. Pub. Util. Comm'n*, No. 62 MAP 2024, Order (July 22, 2025), attached hereto as "**Exhibit A.**"

5. Consistent with the Commission's March 4, 2025 Order, the parties hereby jointly notify the Commission of the final disposition of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court appeal.

6. The parties respectfully request that the Commission schedule a telephonic conference for purposes of discussing a schedule to govern the above-captioned proceeding moving forward, including establishing a new deadline for Repsol to file any responsive pleading.
