**RE: Fred and Reva Levy v. Pennsylvania-American Water Company
Docket Nos. C-2025-3053847 and C-2025-3053848**

Dear Secretary Homsher:

On August 6, 2025, Pennsylvania-American Water Company (“PAWC” or the “Company”) was served with a Request for Continuance (“Continuance Request”) of Fred & Reva Levy (“Complainants”) in the above-referenced proceedings. The Complainants did not serve PAWC with the Continuance Request. Service of the Continuance Request was effectuated via electronic mail by Eric H. Ball, Legal Assistant I, of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) Office of Administrative Law Judge.

PAWC opposes a continuance in this matter for several reasons.

First, the date-stamp on the Continuance Request indicates that it was filed with the Commission on July 25, 2025. The Evidentiary Hearing took place on July 22, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. Thus, the Continuance Request was filed with the Commission 3 days after the Evidentiary Hearing took place. Both the April 4, 2025, Prehearing Order (“PHO”) and the May 28, 2025, Cancelled/Rescheduled Initial Telephonic Hearing Notice (“Notice”) in the above-referenced proceedings stated that: (1) failure to appear may result in dismissal of the case(s); and (2) Continuance Requests must be made at least five (5) business days in advance of the Evidentiary Hearing. Here, the Continuance Request appears to have been filed eight (8) business days after the due date for making such a request, and PAWC was not served with the Continuance Request until fifteen (15) business days after such a request was due and fifteen (15) total days after the Evidentiary Hearing took place.

Second, both the PHO and the Notice stated that continuance requests will be granted only for “good cause.” The Continuance Request submitted by the Complainants contained no indication as to the reason for the requested continuance, nor any reason as to the Complainant’s failure to appear at the July 22, 2025, Evidentiary Hearing. Thus, PAWC submits that good cause has not been shown for granting the Continuance Request.

Third, PAWC was never contacted by the Complainants to discuss the Continuance Request, and the Continuance Request does not state whether PAWC agreed to the Continuance Request, or if the Complainants did not know. This is in violation of the directives in both the PHO and the Notice.

Therefore, for the foregoing reasons, PAWC objects to the Complainant’s late Continuance Request and requests that the Honorable Administrative Law Judge Marta Guhl deny the same.


