Re: Act 127 of 2011, 58 P.S. PA Code §801.101 – Termination of Operations – Leatherstocking Pipeline Company

Dear Secretary Chianetta:

This letter serves as formal notification that Leatherstocking Pipeline Company LLC has ceased operations as a Pennsylvania pipeline operator as of May 2024.

While a pipeline operator, the company maintained a single facility located on Lane Road in Lawton, PA. This facility included a tap on the Lazer Williams pipeline, a short section of transmission main, a gate station, and a service line to the Pennsy Asphalt Plant. The plant ceased operations several years ago, and in 2024, we received confirmation that it would not resume operations.

Following that confirmation, we terminated our agreement with Lazer Williams and physically disconnected from their pipeline, eliminating our ability to take gas. All associated equipment has been decommissioned, and the pipeline was purged and formally taken out of service. While some assets have been sold, the majority remain decommissioned on-site.

Given the decommissioning its single pipeline asset and sale of portions of that asset, Leatherstocking Pipeline Company no longer owns or operates equipment or facilities in this Commonwealth for the transportation of gas or hazardous liquids by pipeline . Accordingly, we request the cancellation of our Act 127 registration.
