**INTERIM ORDER  
GRANTING CONTINUANCE**

Audrey Edwards (Complainant) filed a formal complaint naming Duquesne Light Company. The Complainant alleged, among other things, that her Duquesne Light meter has not been operating properly or recording her actual usage accurately as it relates to energy generated by her solar panel system.

A hearing in the above case convened as scheduled on August 12, 2025. Both the Complainant, Audrey Edwards, and counsel for Duquesne Light, Megan Rulli, Esquire appeared along with several witnesses. The parties engaged in settlement negotiations but were unable to resolve their dispute. However, Ms. Edwards expressed a desire to present data from an app that recorded information from her solar panel system, but she would need time to create an exhibit from the app. She requested a continuance. Duquesne Light did not object.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Complainant's request for continuance is granted.

2. That the Complainant will provide information from her phone app to counsel for Duquesne Light on or before **August 27, 2025**. In the event the Complainant cannot meet that deadline she shall immediately notify Ms. Rulli and agree on a later date.

3. That on or before **September 10, 2025**, counsel for Duquesne Light shall file a status report which has at least three alternate dates when all parties and their witnesses are available for a rescheduled hearing. In the event that the parties have had productive settlement discussions, the status report may request further continuance.

4. That a new prehearing order will be issued following the scheduling of a further hearing. Both parties should review the instructions in that order carefully and serve new proposed exhibits.

5. That the parties are expected to remain in communication and continue to attempt to resolve their dispute consistent with Commission policy favoring settlements.
