Re: CAUSE-PA Request for an Extension to the Comment Period

On July 24, 2025, the Commission entered an Order (July 24 Order) in the above-captioned proceeding and directed UGI Utilities, Inc (UGI) to file and serve supplemental information within 30 days (*i.e.*, by August 25, 2025). The Commission also established comment and reply comments periods; with comments due 20 days after the supplemental information filing deadline and reply comments due 15 days thereafter. July 2024 Order at 76, OPs #3 and 4.

On August 12, 2025, the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (CAUSE-PA) filed a Petition (CAUSE-PA Petition) requesting a 20-day extension of the comment period. CAUSE-PA asserts that it has multiple conflicting deadlines as well as staffing limitations which inhibit its ability to meet the anticipated current deadline of September 15, 2025, to file comments. CAUSE-PA submits that the additional 20 days would help ensure adequate time to review and comment on UGI's proposed 2026-2030 Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan, the July 24 Order, and UGI's supplemental information. CAUSE-PA Petition at 1.

CAUSE-PA reports that it has consulted with the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) and UGI and states that it understands OCA to support and UGI to be unopposed to the extension request. CAUSE-PA Petition at 2. To date, no opposition to the CAUSE-PA Petition has been received.

Accordingly, CAUSE-PA's request for a 20-day extension to the comment period is granted. Comments for all stakeholders are now due 40 days after the supplemental information filing deadline (*i.e.*, by October 6, 2025) and reply comments are due 15 days thereafter (*i.e.*, by October 21, 2025).
