SECTION 1
RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - HOURLY RATES

Rates begin from the time the carrier's vehicle and moving crew leave the carrier's place of business (including arrival at the first point of origin, loading of the shipment, transportation to any additional stops and loading or delivery time at those locations, transportation to the final destination and unloading) and the return of the vehicle and moving crew back to the carrier's place of business.

ITEM 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Household goods are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of the householder and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. The carrier does not offer Full-Value Replacement Protection. If Full-Value Replacement Protection is desired, the client should purchase through a private insurance provider.

ITEM 40 - ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

Any parking fees or tolls incurred at the client's origin, destination or while the shipment is in transit will be the responsibility of the client and added to the carrier's charges.

ITEM 50 - PAYMENT POLICY

The carrier will accept the following forms of payment: COD only (Cash on Delivery), Cash, Credit or Debit Cards (Visa, Mastercard, American Express or Discover). Payment of moving charges must be paid in full (subject to the estimate + 10% rule) at the completion of local moves (shipments transported 40 miles or less) and must be made prior to the delivery on intrastate moves (shipments transported in excess of 40 miles).

ITEM 60 - DEPOSIT & REFUND POLICY

The carrier will accept cancelation of services up to 10 business days prior to the schedule move date via written notification to mattlockevi@gmail.com or by mail sent to 655 2nd Street Pike, Southampton PA 19866. If services are cancelled less than 7 business prior to the scheduled move date, the shipper shall receive a partial refund of prepaid deposits. Forfeited deposits will be used to pay for expenses incurred due to lack of notice of the cancellation. If cancellation of service by the carrier and/or the shipper occurs at time of pick up, the shipper will be held liable for the payment of all services rendered at that time per the carrier's applicable tariff rates.

SECTION 1

RULES & REGULATIONS (continued from previous page)

ITEM 70 - INFESTATION

The carrier reserves the right to refuse the shipment of any household goods believed to be infested with ants, termites, cockroaches, bed bugs or any dangerous or disease bearing insects. Should the carrier's vehicle be infested with the same as a result of the condition of the shipper's premises either at origin or destination, the carrier reserves the right to charge back the shipper for fumigation of the vehicle.

ITEM 80 - IMPRACTICAL OPERATIONS

Nothing in this tariff shall require the carrier to perform any service at any point or location where, through no fault of the carrier, the furnishing of such services shall be deemed as impractical because:

- a. The condition of roads, streets, driveways, alleys or approaches thereto would subject the carrier to unreasonable risk of loss or damage to life or property.
- b. Loading or unloading facilities are inadequate.
- c. Any force majeure, war, insurrection, riot, civil disturbance, strike, picketing or other labor disturbance would (1) subject the carrier to unreasonable risk of loss or damage to life or property or (2) unreasonably jeopardize the ability of the carrier render transportation or pickup or delivery or any other form of service to or at other points or locations.
- d. Carrier's hauling contractors, carrier's employees or carrier's agents are precluded, for reasons beyond the carrier's control, from entering premises where pickup or delivery is to be made.
- e. Local, state or federal restrictions, regulations or laws prohibit the performance of such services by line-haul equipment.

ITEM 90 - ARTICLES OF EXTRAORDINARY VALUE

Items of extraordinary value, as defined by contract law, including but not limited to jewelry, documented antiques of any type, documented art work of any type, coins, stamps, cards or other collections, will not be moved and/or stored, unless accompanied by specific proof of insurance for the same.

ITEM 100 - PROHIBITED & RESTRICTED ARTICLES

1. Carrier will not be responsible for any perishable article or articles included in the shipment without the knowledge and approval of the carrier.
2. Carrier WILL NOT ACCEPT for shipment, under any circumstance, tanks or bottles designed to contain butane or propane (lp), including tanks and containers for gas barbecue grills, torches, tools or appliances. This prohibition also includes tanks or bottles that have been certified as empty.
3. Carrier WILL NOT ACCEPT for shipment, under any circumstance, any explosives or other flammable, hazardous or dangerous material for transportation such as but not limited to perfumes, oils, chemicals, aerosol cans, ammunition or poisons.
4. Carrier WILL NOT ACCEPT for shipment, under any circumstance, any items containing liquid of any type such as but not limited to detergents, soaps, liquors, paint, bottles of water or other drinks, oils or perfumes.
5. Carrier WILL NOT ACCEPT for shipment, under any circumstance, any items containing any species of exotic or domestic animals.

RATES & CHARGES

ITEM 200 - STANDARD HOURLY MINIMUM

- Regular hours apply when services are performed Monday through Saturday between 6:00AM and 7:00PM
- Overtime rates apply when services are performed Monday through Saturday between 7:01PM and 5:59AM
- Rates shown for Sundays and Holidays (any hour) will apply on those days
- Minimum charges based on a total of four (4) hours will apply when services are performed during regular hours
- Minimum charges based on a total of four (4) hours will apply when services are performed during overtime hours
- Minimum charges based on a total of five (5) hours will apply when services are performed during overtime hours

ITEM 210 - HOURLY RATES FOR LOCAL MOVES (shipments traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported forty (40) miles or less)

**SECTION 3
TRANSPORTATION RATES**

ITEM 600 - INTRASTATE RATES

Rates are in cents per 100 pounds, apply to actual weight (subject to minimum weights as provided in rules herein) and include loading and unloading and the actual movement or transportation of property from origin to destination. These rates apply to shipments traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported in excess of forty (40) miles.

Break Point indicates weight at which a lower charge develops by use of lowest weight and applicable rate in next higher weight bracket.

NOTE 1 - For shipments transported less than 150 miles, the minimum weight is 2,100 pounds, For shipments transported 150 to 299 miles, the minimum weight is 4,000 pounds and for shipments transported 300 miles or more, the minimum weight is 8,000 pounds.

SECTION 4
MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES

ITEM 700 - SPACE RESERVATION & OTHER ACCESORIAL CHARGES

THE FOLLOWING NOTES APPLY TO SHIPMENTS TRAVELING BETWEEN POINTS IN PENNSYLVANIA AND TRANSPORTED IN EXCESS OF FORTY (40) MILES:

SPACE RESERVATION FOR A PORTION OF VEHICLE

Subject to the availability of equipment, shipper may reserve a portion of the capacity of a vehicle by ordering a specific quantity of space, and accepting transportation charges based on actual weight of the shipment subject to minimum weights as follows:

When shipment consists entirely of household goods: 300 cubic feet or less - 2,100 pounds

More than 300 cubic feet - 700 pounds per each 100 cubic feet or fraction ordered thereof.

TOTAL CUBIC FEET OF SPACE RESERVATION CANNOT EXCEED THE TOTAL CUBIC FEET OF VEHICLE USED TO TRANSPORT THE SHIPMENT.

Bill of Lading and Freight Bill to be marked or stamped:

SPACE RESERVATION WITH THE CUBIC FEET ORDERED

CUSTOMER SIGNATURE IS REQUIRED FOR SERVICES

SHUTTLE SERVICE

When due to problems with access to or from a residence (excessive long carry, steep grade, etc.), carrier may assess a charge for shuttle service. Cost for shuttle service is \$15.00 per 100 pounds (includes the shuttle vehicle and additional labor required to perform the shuttle).

WAITING TIME

When customer does not arrive at destination to accept delivery at the time agreed upon with the carrier, the carrier may assess a charge for waiting time based on \$50.00 per hour per vehicle and \$75.00 per crewmember subject to the following: For shipments transported 200 miles or less, customer is entitled to one (1) hour of waiting time at no additional charge and on shipments transported in excess of 200 miles, customer is entitled to two (2) hours of waiting time at no additional charge.

ELEVATORS, STAIRS & EXCESSIVE DISTANCES

When a shipment has stairs, elevator or long carrier at origin, extra stops or long carries, the following charges will apply based on the actual weight of the shipment and subject the following:

Stairs - (a flight is defined as six steps or more) - Additional cost per flight is \$2.00 per 100 pounds

When an elevator is present at origin or destination, the additional charge per elevator is \$3.00 per 100 pounds

Long Carry - (a long carry is defined as each 50 feet or fraction thereof after the first 75 feet - Additional cost per long carry is \$2.00 per 100 pounds - (first 75 feet of a long carry is performed at no additional charge)

EXTRA PICKUP OR DELIVERY

When an extra stop or extra stops are included in the shipment, the additional cost is \$60.00 per extra stop

SECTION 5

LOCAL FUEL COST RECOVERY CHARGE

ITEM 800 - LOCAL FUEL SURCHARGE

The following Fuel Cost Recovery Surcharge will apply as follows on shipments of household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania, transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

- (a) The Fuel Cost Recovery Surcharge will be calculated using a "BASE PRICE PER GALLON" of \$1.267.
- (b) On the first Monday of each calendar month, the "CENTRAL ATLANTIC" average price per gallon of diesel fuel will be determined based on the price stated by the U. S. Department of Energy (DOE), Energy Information Administration (EIA) survey of "Retail-On-Highway Diesel Prices." This price will be obtained by calling the DOE Fuel Hot Line at 202-586-6966 or via the DOE Internet Website at www.eia.doe.gov.
- (c) If the first Monday of the calendar month is a federal holiday, the price will be determined based on the stated DOE price available on the next subsequent business day (Tuesday).
- (d) The DOE fuel price obtained will then become effective on the fifteenth (15th) day of the same month. The adjustment determined will apply for shipments loaded beginning on the 15th day of the month and remain in effect through the 14th day of the subsequent following month starting from the effective date of this item.

THIS PROCESS WILL CONTINUE MONTH AFTER MONTH BASED ON THE "NEW" MONTHLY FUEL COSTS.

FOR EXAMPLE

If the reported price of self-service diesel fuel determined on Monday, 10/01/2018, is \$3.447 per gallon, that amount will apply for the purpose of calculating the difference between that amount and the base price of \$1.267 per gallon for shipments loaded as of October 15, 2018 to November 14, 2018.

TO DETERMINE THE FUEL ADJUSTMENT AMOUNT TO APPLY, FIRST DETERMINE THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE "BASE PRICE PER GALLON" AND THE MOST CURRENT SELF-SERVICE DIESEL FUEL PRICE PER GALLON.

IF TOTAL MILEAGE IS 75. AVERAGE MILEAGE PER GALLON IS FIVE (5). FUEL CONSUMED IN GALLONS IS FIFTEEN (15). INCREASED FUEL DIFFERENCE IS \$2.18 TIMES 15 GALLONS OR \$32.70 SURCHARGE.

SECTION 6

INTRASTATE FUEL COST RECOVERY CHARGE

ITEM 900 - INTRASTATE FUEL SURCHARGE

The following Fuel Cost Recovery Surcharge will apply as follows on shipments of household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania, transported distances in excess of forty (40) miles.

(a) The Fuel Cost Recovery Surcharge will be calculated using a "BASE PRICE PER GALLON" of \$1.267.

(b) On the first Monday of each calendar month, the "CENTRAL ATLANTIC" average price per gallon of diesel fuel will be determined based on the price stated by the U. S. Department of Energy (DOE), Energy Information Administration (EIA) survey of "Retail-On-Highway Diesel Prices." This price will be obtained by calling the DOE Fuel Hot Line at 202-586-6966 or via the DOE Internet Website at www.eia.doe.gov.

(c) If the first Monday of the calendar month is a federal holiday, the price will be determined based on the stated DOE price available on the next subsequent business day (Tuesday).

(d) The DOE fuel price obtained will then become effective on the fifteenth (15th) day of the same month. The adjustment determined will apply for shipments loaded beginning on the 15th day of the month and remain in effect through the 14th day of the subsequent following month starting from the effective date of this item.

THIS PROCESS WILL CONTINUE MONTH AFTER MONTH BASED ON THE "NEW" MONTHLY FUEL COSTS.

FOR EXAMPLE

If the reported price of self-service diesel fuel determined on Monday, 10/01/2018, is \$3.447 per gallon, that amount will apply for the purpose of calculating the difference between that amount and the base price of \$1.267 per gallon for shipments loaded as of October 15, 2018 to November 14, 2018.

TO DETERMINE THE FUEL ADJUSTMENT AMOUNT TO APPLY, FIRST DETERMINE THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE "BASE PRICE PER GALLON" AND THE MOST CURRENT SELF-SERVICE DIESEL FUEL PRICE PER GALLON.
