Request for Information

- 1.) Question #10 of the application. (Proposed service).

In your application you gave no sign of a plan for a Pennsylvania facility within 60 days of conditional approval. Please include discussion on how your business located in Monroe, Ohio will adequately service between points in Pennsylvania.

- 2.) Question # 3 of the Verified Statement.

Krishna Natarajan submitted experience indicating working for FLV Logistics LLC full-time from 3/18/2019 and 8/16/2019 to present day.

A.) Please explain the discrepancy on these start dates.

B.) Were there any breaks in employment and/or any revocations of authority during this given time frame? If so, explain when and why?

- 3.) Question # 4 of the Verified Statement.

105 Stablewatch Court, Monroe, Ohio 45050 seems to be a private residence. It was stated FLV Logistics LLC will operate from a commercial facility located in Monroe, Ohio.

A.) What is the exact address of this commercial facility?

B.) Please also provide a clear description of where your vehicles will be parked at this commercial space.

C.) What are the plans for storing shipper's goods, if the move cannot be completed in one day?

D.) Describe how the yard and warehouse are secure.

4.) Question # 5 of the Verified Statement.

Please review the requirements of the following chapters of 52 Pa Code and provide a required plan for drivers that fully demonstrates compliance with the below cited statutes.

A.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 391.11- Age restrictions (minimum age).

B.) 52 Pa Code § 31.134 - Criminal history. (Frequency of record check, disqualification of employment, and record retention).

C.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR part 391.31- Road Test. (related to training program).

What are the criteria for successful completion of training? How long is the probationary period?

D.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 382- Controlled Substances and Alcohol Use and

Testing. Please give the names of companies you are considering conducting drug/alcohol preemployment, post-accident, and random tests.

5.) Question #7 of the Verified Statement.

Who will be conducting PA vehicle inspections?

6.) Question # 8 of the Verified Statement.

To be clear, have you already confirmed that the mentioned policy will support the filing of the required Form E and Form H with the Commission?

7.) The Statement of Financial Position.

A.) Please verify that all assets and debts listed (for example: vehicle loan balances/vehicle asset value, etc.) in the submitted Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet) are held by the applicant (FLV Logistics LLC) and not the member(s). Any property listed

MUST be held to the company which is applying for authority. In your submission, you provided information which states the company owns land/building(s). We need to know if the applicant is co-mingling its assets/debts, which is not permissible. If you have erroneously comingled the applicant's company assets/debts with those of the company member's personal assets/debts, then a revised Balance Sheet with an explanation of what was changed and why is required.

- Please ensure that the figures provided are accurate as of the date provided on the balance sheet, and that all figures provided are based on the best available information.

The information is to be exact.

B.) Submit proof of ownership of the claimed vehicles and the land/building, such as registrations, titles, purchase agreements, etc. All proof must be in the name of FLV Logistics LLC.

- Any assets which may need transferred to the applicant should happen prior to adding them to the balance sheet.

C.) Your vehicles' valuations are higher in comparison to online search; you should provide an explanation as to why.

- FYI - Moving supplies are not considered vehicle assets on this balance sheet. We suggest moving any supplies to the office equipment line with an explanation.

D.) Specify what the "other liabilities" of \$506,774.00 represents as the schedule was not attached as requested on the balance sheet.

E.) At this point it is expected that the applicant's account is now filled and ready to commence operations with the ability to provide safe, efficient, and reliable service. Please provide supporting documentation for the balance sheet. Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements or notarized/official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers (with current contact information) in the name of "FLV Logistics LLC" (account numbers may be redacted).

8.) Are you familiar with the unique set up of a PA tariff with the weight and mileage chart (no binding estimates)?

Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged.
