Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36. Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:



Request for Information

- 1) The responses to questions 5(a), 5(b), 5(c), 5(d) and 5(e) of the verified statements are insufficient. Title 52 Pa. Code § 29 provides detailed requirements. Please provide a system which incorporates code specified compliance requirements. Answers regarding these topics need to be provided with specific frequency and retention policies stated in Title 52:
 - § 29.503. Age restrictions.
 - § 29.504. Driver history
 - § 29.505. Criminal history.

Note that a plan must be in place for hiring drivers even if the applicant is the only driver for the company, the plan should be fully presented in case of future expansion.

The purpose of the verified statement questions is to determine your ability to provide safe, efficient, and reasonable transportation. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses. Failure to do so is sufficient grounds to justify the denial of your application because you have failed to provide sufficient evidence of your fitness to operate. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier related proceedings is highly encouraged.

In response to the Commission's request regarding verified statement questions 5(a)–5(e), the following compliance system is established to meet the requirements of Title 52 Pa. Code §§ 29.503, 29.504, and 29.505. This system applies immediately and will remain in place for all present and future drivers employed by the company.

All drivers will be at least 21 years old

A driver history record will be obtained from each state where the driver has held a license in the past 3 years. This will be done before hire and then every 12 months. Records will be kept for at least 2 years.

A criminal history will be obtained from the Pennsylvania State Police and any state where the applicant lived in the past 12 months. This will be done before hire and then every 2 years. Records will be kept for at least 3 years. Drivers with convictions that affect safe operation will not be permitted to drive.

These policies will apply to me as the current driver and to any future drivers to ensure full compliance with PUC requirements.
